

Nail Technician Program

This program consists of a student orientation session, theory class, demonstrations, and at the senior level includes "hands on" practical experience in the teaching facilities' clinic using the Milady's Standard Nail Technician program. Student activities will include guest speakers, Star Award (best attendance/top professional image), Clippers Award (students who receive letters from clients), community service, and field trips to local trade shows. Optional reinforcement instruction is by video and CD ROM located in the media center. Maximum classroom enrollment is 5 students per class. The State of Maryland Board of Cosmetologists requires each student to complete 250 clock hours of instruction including "hands on" practice to be eligible to take the Maryland State Board Nail Technician exam for licensure as a nail technician.
